### Old Business

The dock cables have all been replaced with new stainless steel cables. The fishing and rental docks have switched places. New anchors were made, installed in the water with buoys to locate them and anchors were placed on the shore as well.

We are still working on a system to make it easier to move the docks in and out on the ramps as the water level changes

### New Business

Parking has become an increasing problem due to more members and guests visiting the lake. To date: there are **26** car parking spaces (2 are designated handicapped) and **12** boat trailer spaces. A property adjacent to WMLCRID was available for purchase - many

District Members have expressed a desire to purchase this property to expand our parking. We will continue working with the county to determine how and if this may be possible in the future.

Concerns regarding the purchase of a large portion of acreage within the WMLCRID boundary and their re-zoning request to make RV sites. If they get re-zoning to create RV parking spaces - this would put a greater burden on parking, staff, sanitation, etc. at the lake property.

I am in the process of getting quotes to expand our rental dock as all current wet slips (8) are reserved for next year and we have a waiting list of 9 more District Members requesting wet slips for next season.
